### [Notes on application procedure]

- If the applicant is not a member of ISEE, he/she needs to contact a member of ISEE to act as co-host. The applicant is requested to obtain permission for this proposal from his/her institute/university and should **discuss the research plan and necessary expenses in detail with the corresponding ISEE researcher (a full-time faculty member of ISEE; not a designated professor) before submission**. - All applications should be submitted through “Joint-Research On-line Integrated System (JROIS)” website (<https://jrois2.isee.nagoya-u.ac.jp>). The application forms can be downloaded from the ISEE website. Please refer to the following URLs:

- In FY2024, ISEE, in collaboration with several institutions, launched “Hub Formation Program: Transdisciplinary Network Linking Space–Earth Environmental Science with History and Archaeology.” This program aims to assess the impact of severe solar storms on modern civilization and to advance history and archaeology through accurate dating, with the goal of creating a space-based society with

sustainable development and to fostering the next generation of human resources. To promote this project, we are now calling for a wide range of transdisciplinary research proposals.

- The applicant as PI (principal investigator) is requested to access the above JROIS website to obtain a login account. After registration on this website, the applicant will receive an e-mail with a password for his/her account. If the applicant has already had an account in the past, he/she can use it again this year. After logging in the JROIS website, visit the application page to enter a set of the project title, the name and the e-mail address of the corresponding ISEE researcher, and then submit the completed application form in **a Zip file** to the website by the deadline. The shaded areas do not need to be filled in.
- Applications to categories 10), 13), 14), 15), 16)-I (first term), and 16)-II (second term) are open to ISEE members.
- Up to one proposal for each category as a PI may be submitted to 01), 04), 05), 06), 07), 08), 12), 13), 16)-I, and 16)-II, in principle.
- A PI of the category 13) may not apply for 01), 02) or 16)-I (first term) in the same fiscal year. When the proposal is not approved, the PI may apply for 16)-II (second term).
- A PI of the category 14) may not apply for 01) or 02) in the same fiscal year.
- A PI of the category 16)-I (first term) may not apply for 13) in the same fiscal year.
- A PI of the category 16)-I (first term) may apply for 16) -II (second term) in the same fiscal year. During the review process, previous approval records for the PI in this category will be considered.
- Deadline for all applications is **January 15, 2025**, except for the category 10).
- The application for category 16) is open twice a year. The application deadline for the first term is January 15, 2025, and that for the second term is the middle of August 2025.

[ISEE Award / ISEE Community Meeting]

- An excellent research activity based on ISEE Joint Research Program will be highlighted as ISEE Award. We accept candidate recommendations each year.
- We may request the PI to report his/her results of the ISEE Joint Research Program at the ISEE Community Meeting held each year.
