

Announcement of opportunity at the Institute for Space-Earth Environmental Research (ISEE), Nagoya University, for the ISEE International Joint Laboratory Project (IJLP)

The Institute for Space-Earth Environmental Research (ISEE), Nagoya University, Japan, seeks for partner institutions for the ISEE International Joint Laboratory Project (IJLP). For each project, one postdoctoral researcher visits ISEE or the partner institution outside of Japan for international collaborative research through matching funds. Two project types can be considered, i.e.:

- (a) One postdoctoral researcher who is employed by ISEE visits the partner institution for one month per year for collaborative research. The cost of the visit (airfare, accommodation and per diem) will be supported by the partner institution.
- (b) One postdoctoral researcher who is employed by partner institution visits ISEE for one month per year for collaborative research. The cost of the visit (airfare, accommodation and per diem) will be supported by ISEE.

The relevant postdoctoral researcher will be selected together by ISEE and the partner institution. Postdoctoral researchers who are already employed by ISEE or by the partner institution may also join this project if both ISEE and the partner institution agree. The length of the visit is nominally one month per year, but it can be changed upon agreement of both institutions.

The period of the project: after 1 April 2025 til 31 March 2028

- 1) Brief project description on scientific questions, purpose, and expected output
- 2) Host researcher in ISEE
- 3) Proposed exchange framework

- (a) A postdoctoral researcher in ISEE visits the partner institution, or
- (b) A postdoctoral researcher in the partner institution visits ISEE.

4-3: Funding arrangements in the partner institution:
